

## Buses & Coaches inside the enclosures at Epsom

The Derby Festival combines fun, fashion and truly memorable racing. For many it is an annual pilgrimage to witness top class horses and jockeys battle it out. A key part of the Derby Day experience is the sight of the open-topped buses lining the course. All enclosures have fantastic views of the track, betting facilities, catering outlets and a party atmosphere.



### The Lonsdale Enclosure

This is the most sought after location opposite the Queen's Stand and next to the Winning Post. Space in this enclosure is strictly limited, as it has fantastic views of the whole day and a chance to get on the rails. On Derby Day only open topped double-decker buses are admitted, but on Ladies Day single and double decker buses can be accommodated.



### The Upper Tattenham Enclosure

Stretching from the grandstands to the famous Tattenham Corner, this popular enclosure accommodates both single and double decker buses and coaches. There's always a great atmosphere, excellent facilities and great views of the racing and across to the downs. Single deck vehicles are arranged in the front row with double deckers in the second row.
